

# LIVERMORE CASINO – THREE CARD POKER 6 CARD BONUS GAME RULES

The object of Three Card Poker is to beat the player/dealer in a three-card poker game. The ranking of hands are as follows:

Rank	Hand
1	Royal Flush
2	Straight Flush
3	Three of a Kind
4	Straight
5	Flush
6	Pair
7	High Card

## Game Rules:

- 1. Three Card Poker is played on either a blackjack-style or poker-style table.
- 2. The game is played with a standard 52-card deck of cards.
- 3. All tables will have some type of signage where the name of the game is displayed, along with the minimum and maximum wager allowed, and collection fee for the players and Player/Dealer. A maximum of five collection rates are allowed in compliance with the California Penal Code.
- 4. The game is played with up to seven players, plus a player/dealer. The house dealer deals the game.
- 5. Players must make an Ante wager (and may make an optional bonus wager) and pay a collection to be dealt in. Each player receives three cards face down. The player/dealer receives three cards two face-down and one face-up.
- 6. Once players inspect their hand, they have two options:
  - a) Fold the hand and forfeit the Ante and Bonus Wager; or;
  - b) Stay in the game by making a Play bet; this bet must equal the Ante.
- 7. The player/dealer must qualify to play with a minimum Queen-high.
  - a) If the player/dealer does NOT qualify,
  - i. The play bet receives no action. The dealer shall immediately refund this bet to players
  - ii. The Ante bet the ones not surrendered by folding shall automatically be paid even money.
  - b) If the player/dealer's hand qualifies,
  - i. and the player's hand beats the player/dealer's, the player wins even money on the Ante and Play bets.
  - ii. and the player/dealer's hand beats the player's, the player loses the Ante and Play bets.
- 8. All bets receive action to the extent that the player/dealer wager covers. If multiple bonus bets are in the same order to receive action and the maximum aggregate payout will be exceeded, the remaining available max. aggregate will be divided by the quantity of those bets and paid out accordingly per bet.
- 9. The round of play ends when the player/dealer exhausts his bankroll, or when all player wagers receive full action.
- 10. The player/dealer position rotates in a systematic and continuous way among the seated players, and no one player may serve as the player/dealer for more than two consecutive hands. The player/dealer button rotates clockwise around the table.

#### **Pair Plus**

Pair Plus is an optional bonus bet for players who placed an ante bet. The rules are as follows:

- 1. Pair Plus bets must be placed prior to the initial deal.
- 2. Pair Plus bet takes into account the three cards initially dealt to the player's hand, with hands of one pair or higher earning a bonus payout.
- 3. The Player-dealer will pay all winning Pair Plus bets and will collect all losing Pair Plus bets.
- 4. In the event that the Player-dealer's wager does not cover the amount wagered by the players, an action button will be used to designate where the action will begin. Additionally, each player's wager receives action in the following order: Ante Bet, Play Bet, Pair Plus Bet, 6-Card Bonus Bet.
- 5. Once the Player-dealer's wager has been exhausted, the wagers not covered by the Player-dealer will be returned to the players.
- 6. Pair Plus bonus bets pay as follows:

3-Card Hand	Payoff
Royal Flush	200:1
Straight Flush	40:1
Three of a Kind	30:1
Straight	6:1
Flush	3:1
One Pair	1:1

### 6-Card Bonus Bet

The 6-Card Bonus Bet is an optional bet for players who placed an ante bet. The rules are as follows:

- 1. The 6-Card Bonus Bets must be placed prior to the initial deal.
- 2. The 6-Card Bonus bet takes into account the three cards dealt to the player's hand and the three cards dealt to the Player-dealer's hand, where the best 5-card poker hand is derived from the six cards. Hands of Three of a Kind or better earn a bonus payout.
- 3. The Player-dealer will pay all winning 6-Card Bonus Bets and will collect all losing 6-Card Bonus Bets.
- 4. In the event that the Player-dealer's wager does not cover the amount wagered by the players, an action button will be used to designate where the action will begin. Additionally, each player's wager receives action in the following order: Ante Bet, Play Bet, Pair Plus Bet, 6-Card Bonus Bet. If multiple bonus bets are in the same order to receive action and the maximum aggregate payout will be exceeded, the remaining available max. aggregate will be divided by the quantity of those bets and paid out accordingly per bet.
- 5. Once the Player-dealer's wager has been exhausted, the wagers not covered by the Player-dealer will be returned to the players.
- 6. 6-Card Bonus Bets pay as follows:

5-Card Hand	Payoff
Royal Flush	1000:1
Straight Flush	200:1
Four of a Kind	100:1
Full House	20:1
Flush	15:1
Straight	10:1
Three of a Kind	7:1

#### Collections

- 1. Collections are as posted on the table.
- 2. The Player-Dealer position rotates every two hands.
- 3. Player must play the previous hand before being eligible to assume the Player-Dealer position.

## Casino Rules

- 1. Collections are taken in advance.
- 2. Players must wager at least the minimum bet of the table limit.
- 3. All cash must be changed to chips.
- 4. Players removing their wager prior to completion of the pay-off may lose the maximum bet or win the minimum bet amount.
- 5. Any attempt to switch, pass, or hold out cards will cause the player's hand to be fouled and forfeiture of that wager to the extent that money covers.
- 6. Players are responsible for the protection of their own wagers.
- 7. Players may assume the Player/Dealer position two hands per round.
- 8. The house does not recognize "kum-kum" bets.
- 9. There is no "kum-kum" banking.
- 10. One player per hand.
- 11. Players may only wager on one hand at a time at the table.
- 12. Any Player wagering on a spot the previous hand has the option of being the Player-Dealer there on the next hand (in turn). If there was no wager on the previous hand, no one may be the Player-Dealer on that spot.
- 13. Management reserves the right to make decisions that are in the best interest of the game. Therefore, under special circumstances a decision may be rendered that is contrary to the strict and technical interpretation of these rules.
